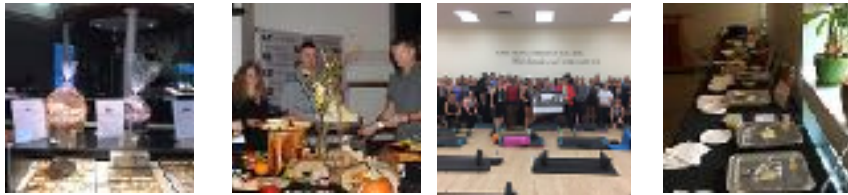
- Sarah R. and family spent a day crafting and painting pottery complete with an Italian family style meal;
